Isabel Ortiz is Director of the Global Social Justice Program at Joseph Stiglitz's Initiative for Policy Dialogue, Columbia University, New York. Earlier she was Director at the International Labour Organization (ILO Geneva, 2013-19) and at UNICEF (New York, 2009-12); senior official at the UN Department of Economic and Social Affairs (New York, 2005-09) and at the Asian Development Bank (Manila, 1995-2003), where she was a founding member of the ADB Poverty Reduction Unit. Earlier, she was at the European Commission and at Madrid University. Isabel Ortiz has worked in more than 50 countries in all world regions, providing advisory services to governments and engaging in high-level initiatives at the United Nations, G20, BRICS, African Union and UNASUR. Additionally, she supports policy work of civil society organizations. She has a MSc and a Ph.D. from the London School of Economics, and has written more than 80 publications translated in several languages.
