

**RESOLUTION No. 1/2024**  
**ON ENDORSEMENT OF THE STRATEGIC PLAN 2025-2028**  
**MEETING OF THE ASSEMBLY OF PARTIES**  
**26 November 2024**

The Assembly of Parties,

*Bearing in mind* Article VI(1)(C)(d) of the Agreement for the Establishment of the International Development Law Organization (IDLO) of 5 February 1988, as amended, and Article 28 of the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly of Parties;

*Bearing in mind* that IDLO's current strategic plan, Strategic Plan 2021-2024, will conclude at the end of the current year;

*Recognizing* the progress that has been made towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, in particular Goal 16, while also acknowledging that the justice gap continues to be wide and IDLO's mandate remains meaningful and highly relevant;

*Noting with satisfaction* the remarkable progress made by the Organization over the past four years in implementing and meeting the goals of Strategic Plan 2021-2024, including in the context of an extremely challenging global environment;

*Welcoming* the efforts of IDLO's Director-General and employees in pursuing wide-ranging and inclusive consultations and developing a new Strategic Plan 2025-2028, which builds on IDLO's strengths, aims to capitalize on emerging opportunities and introduces innovation geared to increase efficiency and effectiveness;

*Resolves to:*

*Endorse* IDLO's Strategic Plan 2025-2028 presented by the Director-General in document AP/2024/3.1;

*Call upon* Member Parties to continue supporting the Organization's important mandate and work, by mobilising resources for the implementation of the new Strategic Plan, including through increased unrestricted funding.

**RESOLUTION No. 2/2024**  
**APPROVAL OF THE MANAGEMENT PLAN 2025-2026 and**  
**OPERATING BUDGET 2025**  
**MEETING OF THE ASSEMBLY OF PARTIES**

The Assembly of Parties,

*Bearing in mind* Article VI(1)(C)(a) of the Agreement for the Establishment of the International Development Law Organization (IDLO) of 5 February 1988, as amended, and Articles 28 to 31 of the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly of Parties;

*Noting* with appreciation the Organization's success in carrying out the previous two-year Management Plan and its resilience in adapting to an extremely challenging global environment;

*Acknowledging* with satisfaction the prudent yet forward-looking approach adopted by the Organization in preparing the draft Operating Budget for 2025;

*Resolves to:*

*Approve* the Management Plan for 2025-2026 as submitted in document AP/2024/3.3;

*Approve* the Operating Budget for 2025, as submitted in document AP/2024/3.4;

*Commend* the Director-General for the progress she has continued to make during 2023-2024 in driving evidence-based thought leadership; pursuing broad and innovative partnerships and enhancing people-centred approaches; building a strong, cohesive team ensuring the cost effective and accountable use of resources; and strengthening membership engagement and diversification of funding;

*Call upon* Member Parties to continue and strengthen their support for the Organization's important mandate and work to promote the rule of law and good governance, including access to justice, which will make a unique collective contribution to the achievement of all the goals of the 2030 Agenda, in particular Goal 16;

*Reiterate* its appeal to Member Parties to invest in the important mandate of IDLO by making an annual voluntary financial contribution, as contemplated by Article V of the Establishment Agreement, and in particular appealing for an increase in unrestricted funding;

*Remind* Member Parties of their commitment under Article VIII of the Establishment Agreement to ensure IDLO's legal status for any operations on their territories by providing rights, privileges, and immunities comparable to those provided to IDLO by Italy in the Headquarters Agreement.

*Call upon* the Director-General to continue to drive evidence-based thought leadership; pursue broad and innovative partnerships and enhance people-centred approaches; build a strong, cohesive team; ensure the cost effective and accountable use of resources; and strengthen membership engagement and diversification of funding.
