IDLO is not bound to accept any Bid, nor award a Contract, nor be responsible for any costs associated with a Bidder's preparation and submission of a Bid, regardless of the outcome or the manner of conducting the selection process.

IDLO encourages every prospective Supplier to avoid and prevent conflicts of interest, by disclosing to IDLO if you, or any of your affiliates or personnel, were involved in the preparation of the requirements, design, specifications, cost estimates, and other information used in this Invitation to Bid (ITB).

By submitting a Bid in response to this information, Bidders are confirming acceptance of IDLO General Terms and Conditions for the Procurement of Goods or Services and IDLO Supplier Code of Conduct in full and; Payment Policy where payment is made within 30 days after delivery of service on presentation of complete and correct invoice.

1. General Considerations	<p>In preparing the Bid, the Bidder is expected to examine the ITB in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested in the ITB may result in rejection of the Bid.</p> <p>The Bidder will not be permitted to take advantage of any errors or omissions in the ITB. Should such errors or omissions be discovered, the Bidder must notify IDLO.</p>
2. Cost of the Bid	<p>The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Bid.</p> <p>IDLO will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the solicitation.</p>
3. Currency of Bid	<p>Bids shall be nominated exclusively in UAH.</p> <p><i>Note: Local Suppliers must comply with any applicable laws regarding doing business in other currencies</i></p>
4. Language of the Bid	<p>The bid is executed in both English and Ukrainian. 17. Validity Period of Bids	<p>All Bids will be valid for 90 days from the deadline for submission of Bids. In exceptional circumstances IDLO may request the Bidders to extend the validity of the Bid beyond what has been initially indicated in this ITB. The Bidders shall be invited to confirm the extension in writing, without any modification whatsoever on the Bid. The Bidders may choose not to extend the validity period of the Bid upon request of IDLO.</p>
18. Modification and withdrawal of Bids	<p>The Bidder may modify/withdraw its Bid after the Bid's submission, provided that written notice of the withdrawal is received by IDLO prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of Bids.</p>

	<p>The Bidder's modification/withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of clause Deadline for Submission of Bids.</p> <p>No Bid may be modified nor withdrawn after the deadline for submission of Bids.</p> <p>No Bid may be modified/withdrawn in the Interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified by the Bidder in the Bid Submission Form.</p>

Amendment of the Bid	<p>At any time prior to the deadline of Bid submission, IDLO may for any reason, such as in response to a clarification requested by a Bidder, modify the ITB in the form of an amendment to the ITB. Amendments will be made available to all prospective bidders.</p> <p>If the amendment is substantial, IDLO may extend the Deadline for submission of bid to give the Bidders reasonable time to incorporate the amendment into their Bids.</p>

22. Clarification of Bids	<p>To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids, IDLO may at its discretion ask the Bidder for clarification of its Bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.</p>
23. 24. Price variation	Bidders shall not vary their prices for any reason after the deadline of the tender and while the Bid is still valid.
25. Preliminary Screening	IDLO will screen the Bids' Annex D and E to determine whether they are complete, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the Bid is generally in order.
26. Correction of errors	In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected by IDLO. If the Bidder does not accept the final price based on IDLO's correction of errors, its Bid will be rejected.
27. Due Diligence	<p>IDLO reserves the right to undertake a due diligence exercise aimed at determining to its satisfaction, the validity of the information provided by the Bidder. ANNEX C
TERMS OF REFERENCE / TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS
FOR PROCUREMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES (TAXI) IN UKRAINE

A. About IDLO

The International Development Law Organization (IDLO) is an intergovernmental organization exclusively devoted to promoting the rule of law. Established in 1983, IDLO works to enable governments and empower people to reform laws and strengthen institutions to promote peace, justice, sustainable development and economic opportunity. Its programs, research and policy advocacy cover the spectrum of rule of law from peace and institution building to social development and economic recovery in countries emerging from conflict and striving towards democracy.

The Assembly of Parties is IDLO's highest decision-making body. It is composed of Representatives of all Member Parties, which have joined the Establishment Agreement of IDLO. IDLO currently has 37 Member Parties.

IDLO has its Headquarters in Rome, a Branch Office in The Hague, Liaison Offices for the United Nations in New York and Geneva, and Country Offices in Afghanistan, Armenia, the Bahamas, Burkina Faso, Honduras, Indonesia, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Jordan, Liberia, Mali, Mexico, Moldova, Mongolia, Myanmar, Niger, the Philippines, Somalia, Tunisia, Uganda and Ukraine.

The work of IDLO is sustained by a dynamic, diverse, multinational and multicultural workforce, comprised of over 400 employees plus additional personnel in the non-employee category such as consultants and interns. About one fourth of the IDLO workforce is based in its Headquarters in Rome, while the rest are spread across the globe in our Branch and Country offices.

B. Background

IDLO aims to provide technical support efficiently, effectively, with accountability and transparency, and as such, the IDLO office in Ukraine is seeking qualified Service Providers to establish a Framework Agreement. The purpose of this procurement is to provide reliable Passenger Transportation Services (Taxi Service) for the IDLO Ukraine Country Office to enable to fulfill its mission and to ensure that IDLO staff members and experts on official business trips get to a place of the destination in the most effective and safest way. The IDLO Ukraine Country Office shall select a transportation company (taxi provider) through a transparent and rigorous procurement process pursuant to the IDLO Procurement Policies and Procedures.

Based on the Framework Agreement the Service is expected to be provided on a "need base". The need of the transportation services required will be identified by placing a Work Order on a "need basis".

C. Condition of Contract and Expected Output

IDLO is looking to establish one or several Framework Agreement(s) with able and qualified Suppliers. A Framework Agreement is a type of agreement with its terms and conditions under which procurement of goods or services can be effected over a specified period, but which places no obligation on IDLO to order any minimum or maximum quantity. All terms and conditions including the prices will remain unchanged during the period of the Framework Agreement(s).

After entering into a Framework Agreement, IDLO shall place order on a “need basis”.

The confirmed award shall be in the form of a duly authorized Work Order. The Work Order is IDLO's commitment against Framework Agreements. The Work Order will provide information on the route of the travel; location, date and time when/where the passenger is to be picked up. The Work Order will also confirm the unit price, lifted directly from Framework Agreement. Additional logistical details may also be included.

The Contractor shall be ready to provide the services at any time during which the Framework Agreement is valid.

This ITB is for **the Framework Agreement for the Procurement of Passenger Transportation Services (Taxi Service)**.

D. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENT

The IDLO Point of Contact will liaise/interact/collaborate with the Contractor prior, during and after the travel to ensure the Contractor receives the travel details on time and completes the performance of the required services.

IDLO POC will notify the Contractor two (2) calendar days in advance at minimum, by means of a Work Order to as IDLO's commitment against Framework Agreement.

The Contractor is responsible for the provision of Vehicles, Drivers, and Maintenance Services of the Vehicles as well as timely performance of the required services.

E. Duration of the Work

The duration for Framework Agreement(s) is 12 months with an option to extend at the same price, terms, and conditions for a second 12-month period subject to satisfactory performance and agreement by both parties.

F. WORK LOCATION

It is foreseen that the Passenger Transportation Services will be provided within Ukraine with the possibility to extend the need of the transportation services across the Border (e.g., Polish or Hungarian border crossing). Anticipated trips include but are not limited to travels between the Ukraine-Polish border crossing and Kyiv, via L'viv. Destinations will be identified on a **"need base"** and indicated in a Work Order submitted to the Contractor.

The Contractor will be required to report on completed trips through the Act of Services rendered.

G. SCOPE OF WORK AND REQUIREMENTS TO THE CONTRACTOR

- Send a passenger vehicle to the location (address) within Ukraine indicated by IDLO.
- Use passenger vehicles by European, Japanese, or American car manufacturers, not older than 10 years, Class C or higher, within the engine capacity up to 3 liters.
- Maintain vehicles in good shape.
- Deploy clean cars, the cabin and externally, taking into account weather conditions.

- Replace the car in case of an unforeseeable malfunction during the trip within a reasonable time.
- Maintain contact with IDLO POC during the entire trip.
- Carry out long-distance intercity trips within Ukraine.
- Accept a new order only upon written request issued in the Work Order, sent by email from the relevant IDLO staff. The order shall be accepted within 24 hours after its receipt.
- Report on travel details (date, route, calculation of the travel expenses).
- Ensure that the driver possesses the license of the relevant category and the agreement (policy) on the compulsory insurance of the civil liability of vehicle owners.
- Ensure that a car has a First Aid Kit as per the required and permitted standards, and that the Driver is able to use the First Aid Kit when needed.
- Maintain sufficient amount of fuel for completion of the trip.
- Have a detour plan should the main route prove impassable.
- Strictly follow traffic rules and regulations.
- Make short stops during the trip upon passenger's request.
- Maintain situation awareness before and during the trip, paying special attention to official security notifications and adjust the route and pace accordingly.
- Acknowledge that IDLO is not responsible for the small number of orders or complete lack of them.

H. Qualifications of the Successful Contractor

Minimum Qualification and Experience of the Contractor:

- a) The Supplier shall submit a valid business registration / tax certificate.
- b) The Supplier shall submit a valid vehicle registration certificate.
- c) The Supplier shall have at least three (3) years of the working experience in providing passenger transportation services (taxi service) in Ukraine and of relevant experience in Car/Vehicle rental operations with other clients with UN or other international organizations.
 - The Supplier shall produce a copy of the national ID and driver's license of drivers employed.

 - The Driver(s) shall provide an active mobile telephone number for communication in case of need or any emergency situation.

I. Scope of Tender Price and Schedule of Payments
